

CONSOLIDATED SUBSCRIPTIONS PAID BY OFFICERS OF THE HOUSEHOLD DIVISION

All serving officers of the Household Division are required to pay a subscription to the Household Division Consolidated Subscription Fund, part of the Household Division Charity.

The rate of the subscription is set by the Major General, Commander Household Cavalry and Regimental Lieutenant Colonels Commanding Regiments and may be varied from time to time.

Each officer's subscription is deducted monthly from his salary as part of the one day's pay scheme and amounts over 12 months to 40% of one day's pay.

In addition to providing officers with their copies of the Guards Magazine, the subscriptions support:

Queen's Guard Officers' Mess Fund (formerly Household Division Mess Fund)
Guards Cricket Club
Guards Saddle Club
Household Division Sailing Association (Gladeye)

The income is allocated by the Major General between these organisations.

Queen's Guard Officers' Mess Fund.

Purpose. The Queen's Guard Officers' Mess Fund exists to:

- a. Administer the Queen's Guard Officers' Mess.
- b. Support other Household Division Messes including the Officers' accommodation at The Queen's Life Guard, Her Majesty's Tower of London and Windsor Castle.
- c. Maintain Household Division Mess property.

Membership. Every Household Division officer is automatically a member of the Queen's Guard Officers' Mess.

Committee. The Queen's Guard Officers' Mess Fund is run by a Committee under the Chairmanship of the Brigade Major.

Other Division Messes. Officers are entitled to membership of all Household Division Messes. Currently there is only one other Household Division Officers' Mess at Wellington Barracks. This Mess welcomes all serving officers. It is however customary that officers should warn in for meals there and especially if they intend to secure the use of rooms and accommodation at that Mess. The Commanding Officer of the London Central Garrison at Wellington Barracks is the Chairman of its Mess Committee.
